Fruiting Trees/Shrubs

Botanical Name	Common Name	Cultivar	Height	Width	Full Sun	Average Water	Description
Ficus carica	Fig Tree		10-20'	10-20'	X	X	Deciduous shrub or small tree. Noted for its spreading habit, attractive foliage and edible fruit. Smooth silver-gray bark is ornamentally attractive. Large, palmate, hairy 3-5 lobed leaves are rough dark green above and smooth light green beneath. Edible figs ripen in late summer or fall on new wood.
Malus	Apple	Empire	12-15'	15'	X	X	The flavor of McIntosh with the sweetness of Delicious. This productive tree is disease-resistant to fire blight and cedar apple rust. Semi-dwarf, bears fruit in 2-5 years, needs pollinator.
Malus	Apple	Hudson's Golden Gem	6-11'	12'	X	X	Semi-dwarf small, cold-hardy tree is upright-spreading. Somewhat resistant to all major diseases. Large fruit looks like an upside-down pear. Light-bronze russetting at base. Fruit has yellow flesh that is very sweet and crunchy.
Malus	Apple	Spitzenberg	12-16'	12-16'	X	X	Heirloom apple, medium-size with crisp, yellow skin covered with inconspicuous red stripes and russet freckles. Flesh is tinged yellow, firm, aromatic, complex in flavor with sprightly and spicy, a perfect balance between sharp and sweet.
Malus	Apple	Spokane	12-16'	12-16'	X	X	Heirloom with massive fruit can weigh up to 2 lbs.! Flesh is snow white, firm, juicy, rich and slightly acidic. The skin has carmine stripe, slight russet; shape roundish to flat. Spokane Beauty apple trees are vigorous growing with strong tip-bearing tendency. So best prune after flowering.
Ribes nigrum	Blackcurrant		3-4'	3-4'	X	X	Deciduous shrub primarily grown for fruit production. Clusters of greenish-yellow flowers bloom in spring and are noticeable but not particularly ornamental. Flowers give way to long, pendant clusters of black currants which ripen in June-July. Currants may be eaten ripe off the shrub, or used to make jams, jellies and pies.
