| Begonia - Polka Dot | Begonia maculata | | | Humid environment, moist | Bright, indirect Light | Toxic |
| Begonia - Trailing | Unknown | | | water only when the potting mix feels dry to the touch | Bright, indirect Light | Toxic |
| Chinese Money Plant | Pilea Peperomioides | | | Medium, allow to dry between waterings | Medium to Bright Indirect | Non- Toxic |
| Coleus - Lime Green | Coleus hybridus | | Pinch frequently to keep bushy | Keep soil slightly moist, not soggy | Bright, indirect | Toxic |
| Coleus - Molten Lava | Coleus hybridus | | | Keep soil slightly moist, not soggy | Bright, indirect | Toxic |
| Coleus - Red Stripped | Coleus hybridus | | | Keep soil slightly moist, not soggy | Bright, indirect | Toxic |
| Donkey's Tail | Sedum morganianum | | | Soak thoroughly; allow to dry | Morning Sunlight | Non- toxic |
| Figs, Fiddle Leaf | Ficus lyrata | Can reach 10' | | Warm, humid environment, water when top 1" feels dry | Bright filtered light | Toxic |
| Hen & Chicken (Tiny) | | | | | | |
| Jade - Common | Crassula ovata | | | Moderate to sparingly | Bright, indirect | Toxic |
| Jade - Trailing | Senecio jacobsenii | | | Moderate to sparingly | Bright, indirect | Toxic |
| Kalnanchoe - Mother of Thousands | Kalanchoe diagremontia | | | Good drainage, allow to dry | Part Sun | Low |
| Kalnanchoe - Red Flowering | Kalanchoe crenata | | | Good drainage, allow to dry | Part Sun | |
| Kalnanchoe -Lavendar Scallops | Kalnanchoe fedschenkoi | | | well-drained, allow to dry slightly | bright light | Toxic |

| Monstera | Monstera deliciosa | | Vining | Allow top 2-3" of soil to dry between waterings | Limited direct sunlight | Mildly toxic |
| Peace Lily | Spathiphyllum spp. | | | Moist but well-drained | Partial sun | Toxic |
| Philodendron | Philodendron spp. | | Low maintenance | Consistently moist, but not wet | Indirect lighting | Toxic |
| Philodendron - Green Congo Plant | | | Low maintenance | consistently moist, but not wet | Indirect lighting | Toxic |
| Pineapple Lily | Eucomis | | | 1" a week in the summer, dryer in the winter | Full sun to part shade | Generally non-toxic |
| Pineapple Sage | Salvia elegans | | | Well-drained, Moist | Full Sun, Partial Shade | Non- Toxic |
| Pothos - Golden | Epipremnum aureum | | | Moist but well-draining | Low to bright indirect light. | Toxic |
| Pothos - Silver | Scindapsus pictus 'Exotica' | | | Moist but well-draining | Bright, indirect light | Toxic |
| Rabbit foot's Fern | | | | Keep moist, but not soggy; needs humidity | Bright but indirect light | Non- toxic |
| Silver Squill | Ledebouria | Upright 6-10" | Easy | Medium, do not overwater | Full/Part Sun | Toxic |
| Snake Plant | Sansevieria sp. | | Easy, Forgiving | Ocassional watering | Low | Toxic |
| Spider Bracken | | | | | | Toxic |
| Spider plant | Chlorophytum comosum | Clumping, longwiry stemsw/white star-shaped flower | | Allow soil to dry slightly between waterings | Medium to bright light | Non- toxic |

| Spiderwort- Brown | Siderasis fuscata | | | Allow to get dry between waterings | Shade to partial shade, temp. 50 to 95 degrees | Toxic |
| String of Pearls | Curio rowleyanus | | | Full to partial | Sensitive to overwatering | Toxic |
| Swedish Ivy | Pilea nummulariifolia | Creeping | | Water when top 1" is dry | Partial shade | Non- toxic |
| Vicks Plant | Plectranthus amboinicus | Mounding | Easy | Not much water, well-drained soil | partial shade | Non- toxic |
| Wandering Dude | Tradescantia Zebrina | | | Moist but well-drained | Full sun, partial shade | Mildly toxic |
| Wax Plant HOYA - Plain | Hoya carmosa | | | Moist, but not wet | High | Non- toxic |
| Wax Plant HOYA - Varigated | | | | Moist, but not wet | High | Non- toxic |
