Type	Common Name	Description	Det/Indet	Days to Maturity
Slicing/Salad	Amana Orange	Heirloom! Huge 2 lb. beefsteak. Light-orange, mildly sweet, almost tropical fruit flavored.	Indeterminate	90
Pasta/Salsa	Amish Paste	Heirloom! 80-12 oz. deep red “oxheart”. Thick, meaty, and tasty. Perfect for paste, sauce and slicing.	Indeterminate	85
Slicing/Salad	Beefsteak	Heirloom! An old time favorite that has been popular for many years. Huge, deliciously juicy, meaty, ribbed fruit on vigorous vines.	Indeterminate	80
Slicing/Salad	Black Krim	Russian Heirloom! 10-12 oz., Violet-red, slightly fattened fruits with nearly black shoulders. Very richly flavored with just a hint of saltiness.	Indeterminate	75
Slicing/Salad	Brandywine	Amish Heirloom! Hugely popular! Large, deep red skin, and smooth red flesh. Exceptionally rich, succulent tomato flavor. Potato leaf plant is best staked or caged.	Indeterminate	75
Slicing/Salad	Carbon	Heirloom! 8-12 oz. fruits. Among the darkest of the “black” tomatoes, dark purplish brown on the outside, deep brick-red on the inside. Delicious, rich, complex flavor.	Indeterminate	75
Slicing/Salad	Dwarf Hannah's Prize	A mid-season, red, dwarf tomato variety, these tomatoes are productive plants with rugose leaves. Their fruit are globe to oblate shaped, red, and weigh 6–12 ounces They have a well-balanced, slightly tart flavor.	Indeterminate	75-80
Slicing/Salad	Dwarf Sweet Scarlet	Potato leaf dwarf variety that produces oblate medium to medium large fruit that ripen scarlet red. The flavor is intense and delicious with perfect balance.	Indeterminate	75
Slicing/Salad	Early Girl	Hybrid. 4-5 oz. red, globe-shaped tomatoes. Long time customer favorite! Early, easy to grow and quite prolific.	Indeterminate	60
Slicing/Salad	Genuwine	Heirloom! This Heirloom Marriage crosses the robust Italian flavor of Costoluto Genovese with the rich perfume of Brandywine. Produces an abundance of squat, pleated slicer tomatoes with all the flavor of its parents and none of their shortcomings.	Indeterminate	70-75
Pasta/Salsa	Giant Oxheart	Heirloom. Good production of huge 2 lb. 4-5” rosy pink, heart-shaped fruits with wonderfully sweet flavors.	Indeterminate	85-90
Slicing/Salad	Green Zebra	Open-Pollinated (OP). Large saladette-sized. Beautiful, yellow-gold with dark green stripes. Tart, lemon-lime flavor. Outstanding!	Indeterminate	72
Cherry	Isis Candy	Heirloom! Cherry tomato with a spectacular cat’s eye starburst on the blossom end. Delicious, sweet taste is rich and fruity. A real taste treat!	Indeterminate	74
Slicing/Salad	Mortgage Lifter	Heirloom! Beefsteak. Rosy-red fruit, exceptional, mild, sweet flavor. A longtime favorite.	Indeterminate	75
Cherry	Oregon Cherry	Hybrid. Cherry tomato from OSU. Red, thin skinned, sweet flavor. A reliable maritime Northwest treat.	Determinate	60

Slicing/Salad	Oregon Spring	Open-Pollinated (OP). From OSU! 4" Bright red, bush variety with great early season flavor. Extra early. Reliable in the Northwest.	Determinate	60
Pasta/Salsa	Paisano	Hybrid! High yielding paste type, vigorous plants yield an abundance of 3 oz. fruits that make outstanding soups and ketchup. An Italian sauce tomato with exceptionally high yields of firm and juicy fruits that are fine for peeling, canning, and fresh eating.	Determinate	70-80
Slicing/Salad	Paul Robeson	Russian Heirloom! 7-10 oz. fruits. Amazing, earthy, exotic flavor. Deep mahogany in color. Sets fruit at lower temperatures.	Indeterminate	75
Slicing/Salad	Persimmon	Heirloom! Beefsteak sized, bright orange, meaty tomatoes that are very sweet with few seeds. One of the best orange tomatoes for flavor.	Indeterminate	75
Pasta/Salsa	Principe Borghese	Italian heirloom! Short determinate plants yields big clusters of 1-2 oz. red, plum shaped, crack-resistant paste tomatoes that are a great substitute for Roma tomatoes. Prized for drying because they retain more flavor. A great sauce tomato or eating fresh in salads or canning.	Determinate	75-85
Pasta/Salsa	Roma	Open-Pollinated (OP). Cylindrical red fruit, meaty with few seeds. Makes great sauce, paste and salsa. A garden staple.	Determinate	72
Pasta/Salsa	San Marzano	Italian Heirloom! Classic roma variety tomato. Prolific producer. Delicious, balanced acidic flavor, and meaty flesh makes this the best for sauces and paste.	Indeterminate	80
Slicing/Salad	Stupice	Czechoslovakian Heirloom! Extremely early, 2" red fruit are born in clusters. Heavy yields all season. Sweet & acidic flavor.	Indeterminate	55
Cherry	Sungold	Hybrid. Very prolific, very sweet tangerine/orange cherry, excellent flavor. The sweetest cherry we've ever tasted! "Candy" for the kids. Requires staking or caging.	Indeterminate	60
Cherry	Sunrise Bumble Bee	Hybrid. Sunrise Bumble Bee is a gorgeous combination of yellows and reds, inside and out. Excellent sweet and tangy flavor.	Indeterminate	70-75
Cherry	Sweet Million	Hybrid. Cherry tomato. Very prolific, early, super sweet red cherry. Crack resistant. A customer favorite.	Indeterminate	60
Cherry	Tumbling Tom Yellow	Sturdy, evenly branched plants are loaded with juicy, 1 to 2" fruits that are deliciously sweet. Perfectly sized for snacking and salads. Cascades to 20" or more.	Determinate	70-80
Cherry	Yellow Pear	Heirloom! Cherry tomato. Highly productive. Beautiful yellow, pear-shaped tomatoes grown in clusters. Mild flavor, and low acid. A favorite with kids!	Indeterminate	70
