Malus	Apple	Hudson's Golden Gem		6-11'	12'	X				X		Deciduous tree, upright-spreading habit, used in orchards or small gardens, white to pink flowers bloom in spring, large yellow-bronze russeted fruit with sweet crunchy flesh ripens in fall, prefers well-drained soil, somewhat resistant to major diseases, moderate maintenance with pruning, fruits in 2-5 years.
Malus	Apple	Spitzenberg		12-16'	12-16'	X				X		Deciduous tree, upright habit, used in orchards or heirloom gardens, white to pink flowers bloom in spring, medium-sized crisp yellow apples with red stripes and complex spicy flavor ripen in fall, prefers well-drained fertile soil, moderate disease resistance, moderate maintenance with pruning, fruits in 2-5 years.
Malus	Apple	Spokane		12-16'	12-16'	X				X		Deciduous tree, vigorous upright habit with tip-bearing tendency, used in orchards or large gardens, white to pink flowers bloom in spring, massive apples up to 2 lbs with white firm juicy flesh ripen in fall, prefers well-drained soil, moderate disease resistance, moderate maintenance with pruning after flowering, fruits in 2-5 years.
Sambucus nigra	Elderberry	Gerda	X	8-15'	4-8'	Х	X			X		Deciduous large shrub or small tree, upright habit, used in mixed borders or hedges, lemon-scented pinkish-purple flowers bloom in early summer, edible purple-black berries ripen in late summer, prefers moist well-drained soil, moderate pest resistance, low maintenance, berries used for jams or wine, fruits in 2-3 years, all parts except flowers and ripe berries are poisonous.

Chaenomeles speciosa	Flowering Quince		X	6-10'	6-10'	X	X			X		Deciduous shrub, spreading tangled habit, used in hedges or as an ornamental, scarlet to pink flowers bloom in early spring, small yellow-green apples ripen in fall, prefers well-drained soil, good pest and disease resistance, low maintenance with occasional pruning, fruits are tart and used for jellies, fruits in 2-3 years.
Cornus florida	Flowering Dogwood		X	15-30'	15-30'	X	X	X		X		Deciduous tree, spreading habit, used as a specimen or in woodland gardens, showy white to pink bracts bloom in spring, red berries ripen in fall, prefers moist well-drained acidic soil, susceptible to anthracnose and borers, moderate maintenance with pruning, berries attract birds, fruits in 2-5 years.
Magnolia virginiana	Magnolia virginiana			15-50'	15-40'	X	X	X		X	X	Deciduous to semi-evergreen tree or shrub, upright spreading habit, used as a specimen or in wet areas, fragrant creamywhite flowers bloom in late spring to early summer, red-seeded cones in fall, prefers moist to wet acidic soil, good pest resistance, low maintenance, fruits attract birds, fruits in 3-5 years.
Ribes uva- crispa	Gooseberry		X	3-5'	3-5'	X	Х			Х		Deciduous shrub, arching habit, used in edible gardens or borders, small greenish flowers bloom in spring, edible green to red berries ripen in summer, prefers well-drained fertile soil, susceptible to powdery mildew, moderate maintenance with pruning, berries used for pies or jams, fruits in 1-2 years.
